

Tub Maintenance Tips and Checklist

With proper care and maintenance, your newly refinished bathtub, sink, countertops, or tile will continue to shine for years to come.

Daily Care

- ✓ Run your bathroom exhaust fan when showering or bathing to reduce humidity and lessen the chances of mold forming along the new caulk lines in your refinished tub.
- ✓ Rinse your tub or shower with water after every use to keep it fresh between cleanings and to ensure soap scum doesn't eat away at your new surface over time.

Weekly Care

Clean your tub, shower, tile, and sink regularly with these tips in mind:

- ✓ Use only non-abrasive cleaner and non-abrasive scrubbing pads to clean your new surface. **Stay** away from powders or soft-scrub gels, as they can deteriorate the surface.
- ✓ Do not use bleach or products that contain bleach.
- ✓ Liquid cleaners and soft cloths or sponges are best.

*We suggest these products: Blue Scotch-Brite pads or microfiber cloths; Zep- Shower, Tub & Tile Cleaner; 409; Lysol Tub & Tile Cleaner; Scrubbing Bubbles; or a DIY mixture of equal parts vinegar & water.

Regular Maintenance Tips

- ✓ Keep an eye open for leaking or dripping plumbing fixtures in your tub, shower, or sink. Drips can have a negative effect on any surface over time.
- ✓ Take the same steps to maintain and protect your refinished surfaces as you would with new ones.
